



## Things to bring to Acadia Trad

Here are some suggestions for you to consider when you're packing for the festival!

*If you're staying on campus at COA, basic linens (mattress pad, pillow, sheets, lightweight blanket, and a towel) are provided for all campus dormitory rooms.*

### Things for your room & around campus:

- Extra towel
- Extra blanket (in case of cold nights)
- Small circulating or box fan (it could also be hot!)
- Slip-on shoes and a bathrobe for walking to the bathroom
- Quarters and laundry supplies if you plan to use the laundry rooms on campus
- Flashlight
- Bug Spray
- Ear plugs (especially if you're sharing a room or a light sleeper)
- Toiletries (including soap)
- Water bottle
- Rain coat / Umbrella (just in case!)
- Back pack / Gig bag (for carrying things to class or around campus)
- Cash (for raffle tickets, evening concessions, faculty merchandise)
- Snacks (dinner is early and nights are long!)
- Yoga mat
- Bathing suit
- COVID tests & masks (just in case!)

### Things for your studies:

- Recording device for classes
- Extra strings / rosin / picks / etc. for your instrument(s)
- Pencils & notebook for taking notes in class
- Secondary instruments (whistle, bodhran, etc. to take advantage of afternoon workshops)
- Dance shoes (even if you're not signed up for dance, so you can join in social dancing!)
- Music stand (if you need one, not required and not all faculty will provide handouts)
