Founded in 2013, the Acadia Trad Festival brings world-class performers, students, and the public together for a week of aweinspiring concerts, dances, classes, and workshops. In June 2023, the event returned for the first time since the start of the COVID pandemic to celebrate the music and dance of Acadian, Cape Breton, Irish, Quebecois, Scottish, and other origins that contribute to the authentic character of Maine and Hancock County. The 2026 celebration will be held as it always has been, at the beautiful oceanfront campus of College of the Atlantic in Bar Harbor, Maine.

The festival attracts approximately 200–250 students for a week of learning and performances. In 2025 our Artistic Team will confirm participation from 27 world class faculty. The Festival offers a series of public events, including four evening concerts featuring these renowned traditional performing artists, and a student concert and contra dance to cap off the week on Friday evening. Approximately 200 patrons attend each of these nightly events and they often sell out. In addition, afternoon and latenight jam sessions are open to the public for a small fee, along with walk-in workshops for learners of all ages and abilities.

Marketing for AFTMD includes email newsletters (1,880 subscribers via Mailchimp), social media posts (4,400 combined followers on Facebook and Instagram), Facebook and Instagram ads by targeted audience, press releases sent to more than 30 news publications throughout Maine and 20 beyond Maine, and listings on over 20 online community calendars. Print ads are placed in a number of top-tier trade publications. Print collateral is distributed to hundreds of locations regionally, and includes posters, brochures, etc.
